OUESTIONS?

Jurn your completed passport in to the Hearst Center for the Arts, Community Main Street office, or Cedar Falls Tourism and Visitors Bureau office. You may also bring your completed passport to Artapalooza. This is, however, not a stampable event. A drawing from completed passports will take place at the Hearst Center kids tent located near the corner of 2nd and Main Streets at 10am. Participants are invited to attend, however you need not be present to win.

It's your responsibility to get your passport stamped at the events. Signage with the Passport to the Arts logo will direct you to the "stamping" station.

A minimum of six stamps from three organizations are required—two for month—this means two in June, July and August. No repeated organizations are allowed in the same month. For example two Movies Under the Moon in June would not be allowed, however you can use one in June and one in July.




